The doctors' treatments to heal Ernesto's physical and invisible wounds failed repeatedly. Where no doctor, family or friend could help, Daisy was able to help heal him. Daisy became a shelter dog turned emotional support dog. Together, Ernesto and Daisy formed the Wounded Paw Project® in 2016 to give other shelter dogs a second tail in life®.

Today, Wounded Paw Project® is guided by the PAW principle and has become the Voice for all dogs.
