

Just like you, your doggie needs to be bathed on a regular basis. This will help maintain their skin and coat health by removing dirt, debris, and allergens, which can help prevent skin irritation, reduce shedding, eliminate bad odors, and overall

promote their hygiene and well-being. Not only that, bathing can be a great bonding experience between you and your dog!

Here are some simple tips to follow to give your dog the best bathing experience:

- Brush your dog before bathing to remove dirt and mats.
 Brushing will also help prevent mats from trapping water and irritating your dog's skin.
- Wet your dog using lukewarm water to avoid drying out your dog's skin.

 Massage shampoo into your dog's coat from head to tail. Be sure to rinse all the shampoo out of your dog's coat to prevent dry, itchy skin and dandruff.

Use a washcloth on your dog's face to keep soap from getting into their eyes, ears, or mouth.


