

Dogfighting is a violent and highly secretive enterprise that is extremely

difficult for law enforcement and investigative professionals to infiltrate even though it is a felony in all 50 states and in the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Possession of dogs for the purpose of fighting or even just being a spectator at a dogfight is illegal. It is still a major issue in communities across the country.

### RECENT DOG FIGHTING RINGS DISCOVERED

April 2024: 120 dogs were rescued in Cumberland County, NJ

June 2024: 32 dogs were rescued in Mobile, AL

July 2024: 111 dogs were rescued in St Petersburg, FL

September 2024: 60 dogs were rescued in Tyler, TX

January 2025: 36 dogs rescued in Deerfield Beach, FL

January 2025: 6 dogs rescued in Milwaukee, WI

1DOGS WITH SCARRING AND **MULTIPLE WOUNDS....ESPECIALLY PITBULLS** 



2.SPRING POLE **NECK AND JAW BE A RAWHIDE** OR TIRE

TO HELP BUILD **MUSCLES. CAN** KNOTTED ROPE SUSPENDED

FROM A STRONG TREE BRANCH



- HARNESSES ATTACHED
- 4. BREAKING STICKS. THESE STICKS ARE USUALLY FOOT LONG, FLAT ON ONE SIDE, MAY HAVE SIGNS OF BLOOD AND ARE USED TO BREAK UP FIGHTS



**FIGHTING RINGS INCLUDING BASEMENT** WALLS THAT HAVE **SCRATCH MARKS AND** TRACES OF BLOOD

WASHTUBS THAT CAN BE USED PRIOR TO A FIGHT FOR HANDLERS TO WASH AND EXAMINE THEIR OPPONENT'S DOG UNDER A REFEREE'S SUPERVISION.



### PEANUT BUTTER AND BANANA CHIPS

Who doesn't love chips? Now your doggie can have a safe alternative to greasy potato chips with this recipe we found on mydogrecipe.com.

### Ingredients

- 2 ripe bananas
- 1/4 cup of peanut butter
- 1/2 cup of oat flour
- 1 Tablespoon of honey

THIS MONTH, SADIE WANTS TO REMIND YOU THAT AS THE WEATHER STARTS WARMING UP YOU NEED TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE GIVING YOUR PET FLEA AND TICK MEDICATION TO PROTECT YOUR DOGGIE (AND YOURSELF) FROM DISEASES TICKS AND FLEAS CARRY, SUCH AS LYME DISEASE, ROCKY MOUNTAIN SPOTTED FEVER, AND THE PLAGUE.

- 1. Preheat the oven to 325°F.
- 2. In a large bowl, mash the bananas using a fork until they reach a smooth consistency. Stir in peanut butter.
- 3. Gradually add the oat flour to the banana and peanut butter mixture, stirring as you go. Stir the dough until everything is well combined. If the mixture feels too sticky, you can add a bit more flour, but be careful not to add too much—you want the chips to remain light and crunchy.
- 4. Place the dough between two sheets of parchment paper and use a rolling pin to roll it out to about ½ inch thickness. Cut out the chip shapes using a small cookie cutter or simply cut the dough into squares or circles using a knife.
- 5. Transfer the cut-out chips to a parchment-lined baking sheet. Bake the chips in the oven for 15-20 minutes, or until they are golden brown and crispy. Cool completely before serving.


